Component 3 Appraising 40% exam	2 set works across 4 Areas of Study: • Musical Forms & Devices • Music for Ensemble • Film Music • Popular Music	1hr 15mins exam 96 marks available (8 x 12 mark questions)			

A significant change to the assessment of the new style 9-1 GCSE in music is that no coursework can be completed and assessed until the terminal year. This does not mean that students will not do work towards their coursework until Year 11, but no formal work on the final pieces can be started until then.
